



# CSOC Summer Camp 2018: A Guide For Families

**The New Jersey Children’s System of Care (CSOC) may be able to provide eligible children, youth and young adults up to age 21 financial support toward camp tuition.**

## Deadline

Completed applications for both Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition and One-to-One Aide Services for Summer Camp must be postmarked or received by PerformCare no later than **April 30, 2018**. Applications, including supporting documentation, **MUST** be complete in order to be considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure all necessary paperwork is on time.

## Important Information

For summer camp 2018, Financial Support toward **Summer Camp Tuition** is for the camp’s daily rate, not to exceed \$80.00 per day for day camp (maximum of 10 days) and not to exceed \$133.00 per day for overnight camp (maximum of 6 nights). Families/caregivers are responsible for the cost of summer camp tuition minus any financial support provided by CSOC.

Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition and One-to-One Aides are not guaranteed. Families and caregivers should consider their financial ability to pay the balance.

When an eligibility determination for Financial Support toward Summer Camp has been made, PerformCare will provide written notification of the decision’s outcome to the family and camp within 30 days. Notices will be mailed after April 30, 2018.

Camps must be from the DCF qualified provider list (see “Links” column)</li> </ul> </li> </ol> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You do not need to complete Part B if you are not requesting One-to-One Aide Services.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the CSOC Qualified Camp you have selected has determined that your child will require the assistance of a One-to-One Aide (advocate) to attend their program, you will be required to complete Part B of the Application for CSOC Summer Camp Services.</li> <li>You and the camp provider must complete the Child Adaptive Behavior Summary (CABS) together on Part B of the Application in order to apply for One-to-One Aide Services.</li> <li>The camp must retain a copy of the jointly completed CABS.</li> <li><b>One-to-One Aide Services are available for CSOC Qualified Day Camps only.</b> One-to-One Aide Provider List: <a href="http://bit.ly/csoconetooneaidelist">bit.ly/csoconetooneaidelist</a></li> </ul>
