The Arc of Atlantic: Camp By the Sea

Since 1999 The Arc has partnered with the Milton and Betty Katz Jewish Community Center in Margate to provide an 8-week inclusive summer camp program for children with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) in conjunction with their Camp By the Sea. Currently this program receives NO state funding. Camp spots are available if a family would like to private pay. Approximate cost for 8 weeks is \$4,600 (without transportation) This is for a 2:1 ratio (two campers to one counselor) Every summer as many as 25 children with I/DD attend camp with the supports they need to have a successful experience with their non-disabled peers.

The Arc of Cumberland: Camp Fisher (Cumberland, Gloucester, Salem and Atlantic Counties)

Camp Fisher is a day camp offered for two weeks in August for eligible children, ages 5 thru 20, and also for adults 21 and older. Children must be approved for funding through the New Jersey Children's System of Care and adults through the New Jersey Division of Developmental Disabilities. The camp is held at our facility's spacious outdoor grounds in Vineland, New Jersey. Our camper-to-staff ratio is four to one. Any campers who need extra personal care or have behavioral challenges must arrange for one-on-one assistance.

While enjoying these activities, attention is also given to daily living skills, peer interaction, socialization skills and developing appropriate behaviors. The campsite is located in Effort, Pa., in the Pocono Mountains a short distance from the New Jersey border. Camp runs June-August and is best suited to campers who can move freely without restriction. Campers must: be able to self-feed, on a regular diet, free of restrictive medical problems free of serious behavioral problems, have physical stamina for active camp program, have independent toilet skills.
