Located on over 30 wooded acres in Williamstown, NJ, Camp Sun 'N Fun boasts a variety of amenities, including air-conditioned cabins, barrier-free bathrooms and showers, an Olympic-sized barrier-free swimming pool, nature trail, open areas for sports and recreation, an on-site medical facility that is staffed 24 hours a day, and Sunshine Inn, an air conditioned building where campers eat and enjoy activities if the weather is very hot or rainy.

For Campers, Camp Sun 'N Fun provides opportunities to make new friends, opportunities to develop independence and opportunity to gain self-esteem through success in fun activities such as nature appreciation, arts and crafts, sports and games, music and dance, theme parties and much more. And, both residential and day camp opportunities are available, so seasoned campers and those new to the camping experience can participate on a level they feel comfortable.

The campsite is located in Effort, Pa., in the Pocono Mountains a short distance from the New Jersey border. Camp runs June-August and is best suited to campers who can move freely without restriction. Campers must: be able to self-feed, on a regular diet, free of restrictive medical problems free of serious behavioral problems, have physical stamina for active camp program, have independent toilet skills. Camp By the Sea

Since 1999 The Arc has partnered with the [Milton and Betty Katz Jewish Community Center](#) in Margate to provide an 8-week inclusive summer camp program for children with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) in conjunction with their [Camp By the Sea](#). Currently this program receives NO state funding. Camp spots are available if a family would like to private pay. Approximate cost for 8 weeks is \$4,600 (without transportation) This is for a 2:1 ratio (two campers to one counselor) Every summer as many as 25 children with I/DD attend camp with the supports they need to have a successful experience with their non-disabled peers. Camp Renape

The Arc of Burlington County's CAMP RENAPE, located on our beautiful wooded camp site in Hainesport, NJ, moves into full summertime mode each August. Lucky campers ages 13 and older get to spend a month of excitement meeting new friends and having a wonderful experience enjoying an extensive recreation program that includes swimming, day trips, arts & crafts, games, sports, musical entertainment, and other activities. Our caring, qualified staff are committed to providing a positive, supportive environment that fosters relationship building, self-esteem development, and independence.

Campers must be at least 13 years of age and are referred either through the Department of Children and Families (DCF) for those 13 – 20 or through the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) for those 21 and over. Other funding is also accepted: self-directed supports, support services, self-pay, etc. Our camper-to-staff ratio is 1:4, and all campers needing extra personal care must arrange for one-on-one assistance.
