

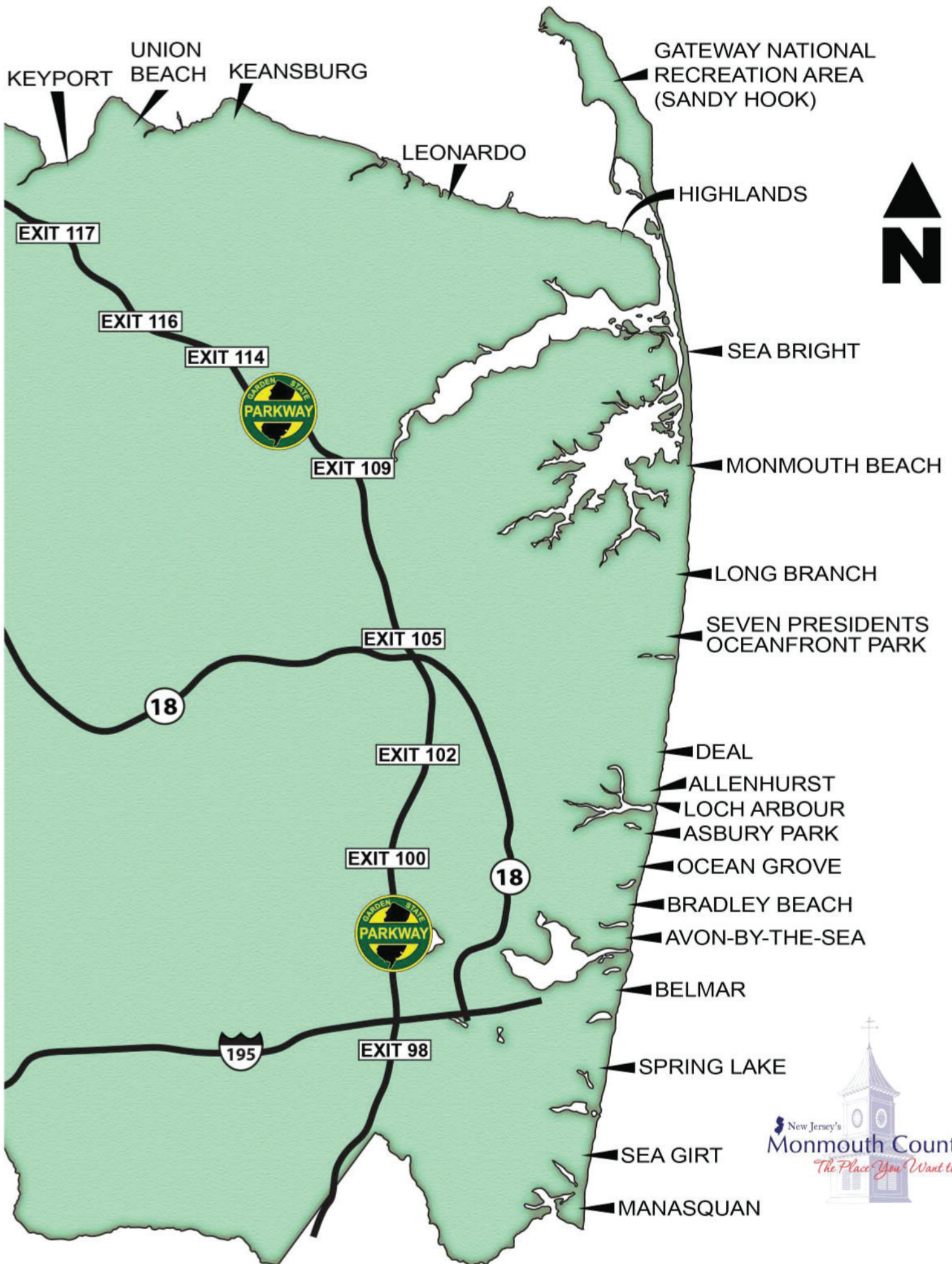

Definitions of frequently used terms

Curb cut - A small ramp built into the curb of a sidewalk to eliminate physical barriers and ease passage to and from the street.



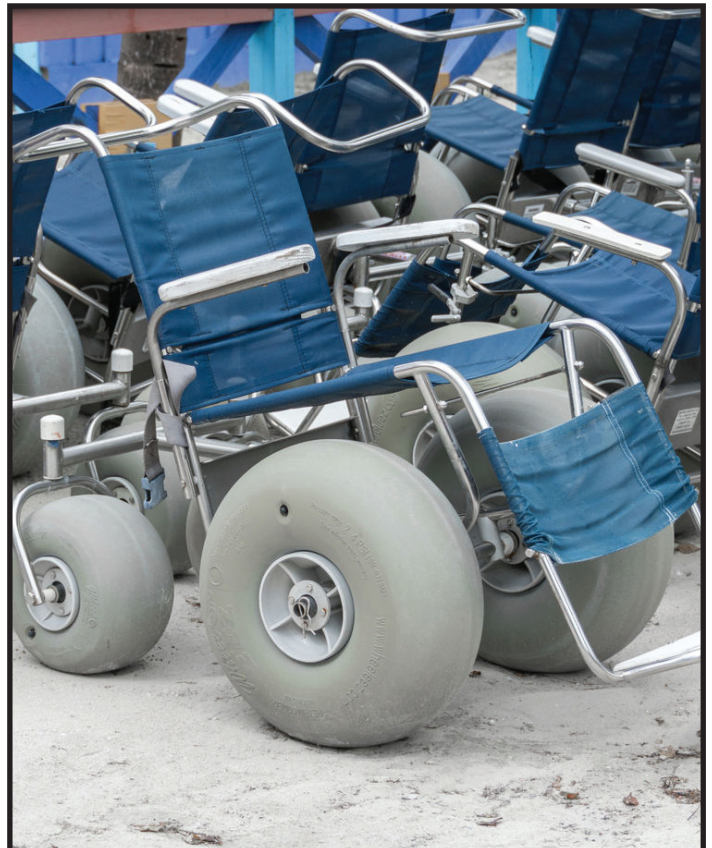
GSP – Garden State Parkway

Mobile beach mat - A multi-purpose, portable and rolled-out hard surface mat that is used as a walkway or roadway. These mats make it possible for a person using a wheelchair, stroller, cane, or walker to access the beach. The mats



are often extended to a beach's high tide mark. Sometimes the mats are called by their trade name of Mobi-Mats™/DuraDeck™/Access Mat™.

Surf chair - A rustproof wheelchair with wide tires that can be pushed easily in sand allowing access to most surface areas of a beach.

Parking: Metered parking. Accessible parking/curb cuts - Available at every block.

Beach Access: Boardwalk - Accessible. Ramp to sand, & mobile beach matt on sand.

Fee: Season badges are \$45 for ages 13- 17, \$70 for adults 18 to 64, and \$25 for adults 65 and older. Weekday beach fees \$8 for individuals 18 years and over, under 17 free on weekdays only. Weekends & holidays \$8 for individuals 13 and over, 12 and under are free. Daily parking pass is \$8. Season Parking Passes \$70. Bus Parking \$25. Persons with disabilities \$15 for season with NJ State Park and Forestry Disability Pass (application at park office). Parking cost included. Active duty military members, veterans, their spouses and dependent family members are admitted free (including parking) with appropriate military ID. Accepted ID includes active duty military/national guard ID cards, retired military ID cards, and or a Monmouth County Veteran's ID card. Please contact 732-431-7324 for information on how to obtain a Monmouth County Veterans ID card.

Lifeguards: On duty weekends from May 27 - June 11, daily from June 17 - September 4, 10 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Surf Chairs: Four surf chairs at pavilion.

Parking: Yes

Beach Access: Equipped with picnicking, snack bar, and restrooms. Playground accessible (see information about Tony's Place). Ramps to boardwalk/beach. Mobile beach mats at main area and North End to high tide mark.

Restrooms: Available at pavilion and near main gate.



Tony's Place at Seven Presidents Oceanfront Park, Long Branch

Directions: GSP North/South Exit 105. Located within Seven Presidents Oceanfront Park, just north of the park pavilion. Playground entrance is marked by colorful flags.

Parking: Parking - Fully accessible parking lot with multiple van and car parking spaces. All parking surface areas flat and directly in front of playground with joining walkway into playground.

Playground Description and Access: Tony's Place is a 13,250 square foot wheelchair-friendly playground designed and built for children of all abilities. Playground has areas for climbing, rolling or pulling through or along ramps, tubes and special play apparatus for children with disabilities. A wide walkway around and through the



playground provides easy access to all equipment; park benches are adjacent to all play equipment for close visual contact with children. The entire playground has a soft landing surface. Fully accessible beach front with mobile beach mat to the high tide mark. To access beach from playground follow boardwalk ramp that begins on the south east corner of playground. Follow wide, elevated boardwalk ramp through scenic, protected dune area that opens to a wide picnic area. Walkway ramp continues on the left and out to the beach with a mobile beach mat that extends out to the high tide mark. Picnic section is accessible just south of playground a short walking distance, equipped with fully accessible food stand.

Restrooms: Accessible restrooms at both playground site and a short distance south of playground. Showers are fully accessible.

Lifeguards: On duty 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Surf Chairs: Six surf chairs available daily at the end of Ocean Avenue (Elks Beach).

Playground: Located at the North End, and swing sets along beach front.

Parking: Season Parking: Limited quantities \$85.00, daily parking \$7.00 Monday - Thursday, \$12.00 Friday - Sunday and any special events in any of the 4 designated beach public parking lots.

Beach Access: Ramps located at north end of beach at Ocean Ave and Elks Beach. Sand walkways available to the high tide mark. 50 foot mobil mats available at all beach entrances. Accessible restaurants and food concession stands located along beach front.

Restrooms: Four accessible public restrooms available along the beach front.

No fee for Access card for persons with disabilities (must provide State disability card, to obtain please contact Monmouth County Division on Aging, Disabilities and Veterans Services at 732-308-3770 ext. 7116). \$75 for season car pass. Go to Lighthouse Keepers' Quarters Visitor Center to purchase all senior and Access Passes. Active duty military & family free with America the Beautiful Annual Pass and military ID, \$80 to purchase pass,
