- The Arc of New Jersey's Mainstreaming Medical Care Program promotes quality health care for people with developmental disabilities throughout New Jersey.

- The program provides information and advocacy on the NJ Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) policy requiring Medicaid eligibility, as well as information on Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI), Disabled Adult Child (DAC) status, and NJ Medicaid -- including Medicaid Expansion.
- The program provides information and advocacy for persons who are dually diagnosed with both a developmental disability and a mental health disorder.
