



Preparing For Camp Checklist

New Jersey Children's System of Care within the Department of Children and Families, which serves youth up to age 21 may be able to provide eligible youth with I/DD financial support toward camp tuition and one-to-one camp aide services.



- Read** the Summer Camp Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

- Make sure your child's camp** is a CSOC camp provider:

- Ask the camp for** an acceptance letter (on camp letterhead) and send it with the application.
- Complete Part A** of the CSOC Summer Camp Application:
bit.ly/csocfinancialsupportcampapp. You do not need to complete Part B if you are not requesting One-to-One Aide Services.
- If applicable, complete Part B** of the application if your loved one requires a one-to-one aide.
- If a one-to-one aide is required, complete the "Child Adaptive Behavioral Summary" (CABS) along with the camp provider.
- Application(s) must be completed and postmarked to PerformCare by **April 30, 2018**.
